UNIFORM POLICY

We encourage students to take care with their grooming and presentation. **Everybody** is responsible for ensuring that uniform standards are maintained.

If a student is unable to wear the correct/complete uniform, they should have a note from home or from the Boarding supervisor.

Please note the following:

- Uniforms must be the right size, clean, ironed and in good repair, and should always be worn correctly, even after school.
- Blazers are compulsory for Year 11 and 12 for Term 2 and Term 3 and are to be worn for assembly and other formal occasions.
- Black leather lace up school shoes are to be worn with Day uniform and Formal uniform. Shoes must be polished and laces tied.
- Sports shoes are to be worn with House and Sports uniform.
- Only BTC sport socks to be worn with PE/House uniform; no ankle socks or football socks.
- The correct hat for the correct uniform is to be worn at all times when outdoors.
- Hair should always be clean, neat and tidy away from the face; natural colouring applies.
- Watches are permitted and encouraged.
- Tape is not acceptable over piercings.
- Under no circumstances are scarves, beanies or balaclavas allowed to be worn.
- College Badges are the only permissible badges to be worn on collars and blazers. It is acceptable to wear a badge or symbol for a cause on the nationally recognised day (only).

Students attending DTTC (Dalrymple Trade Training Centre) in the morning are to wear the correct, authorised clothing to DTTC and are to change into appropriate school uniform immediately upon their return to school.

Girls

- One matching set of earrings only (one in each earlobe). **Stud OR sleeper** earrings only - gold or silver; NO other visible piercings are acceptable.
- Long hair styles have to be tied back - buns, pig tails, plaits or ponytail - ponytail can be tucked under - no hair poking out. Keep in mind hats must be worn. NO radical hairstyles.
- A navy scrunchie is a uniform requirement for girls with long hair and must be worn at all times. Girls who do not present with a navy scrunchie to school everyday will be given one from the office and charged to the family account. House coloured ribbons etc. can be worn with House Uniform.
- NO visible make-up or nail polish allowed.
- Skirt length - should be an appropriate length for the school environment as determined by staff.
- Only necklaces with a recognised religious significance may be worn and should be worn under clothing so that they are not visible.
- No bangles, bracelets, anklets, rings are to be worn.
- In Winter: Black or navy stockings may be worn (they must not be worn with socks).

Boys

- Boys must always be clean-shaven and groomed.
- No piercings are acceptable.
- Only necklaces with a recognised religious significance may be worn and should be worn under clothing so that they are not visible.
- No bangles, bracelets, anklets, rings are to be worn.
- Hair must be shorter than eyebrow length at the front, above the ears and off the collar at the back. NO radical hairstyles.
- Long school socks should be pulled up.
- Day and Formal shirts **should be tucked in at all times.**
- Black belts must be worn with both formal shorts and long trousers.
